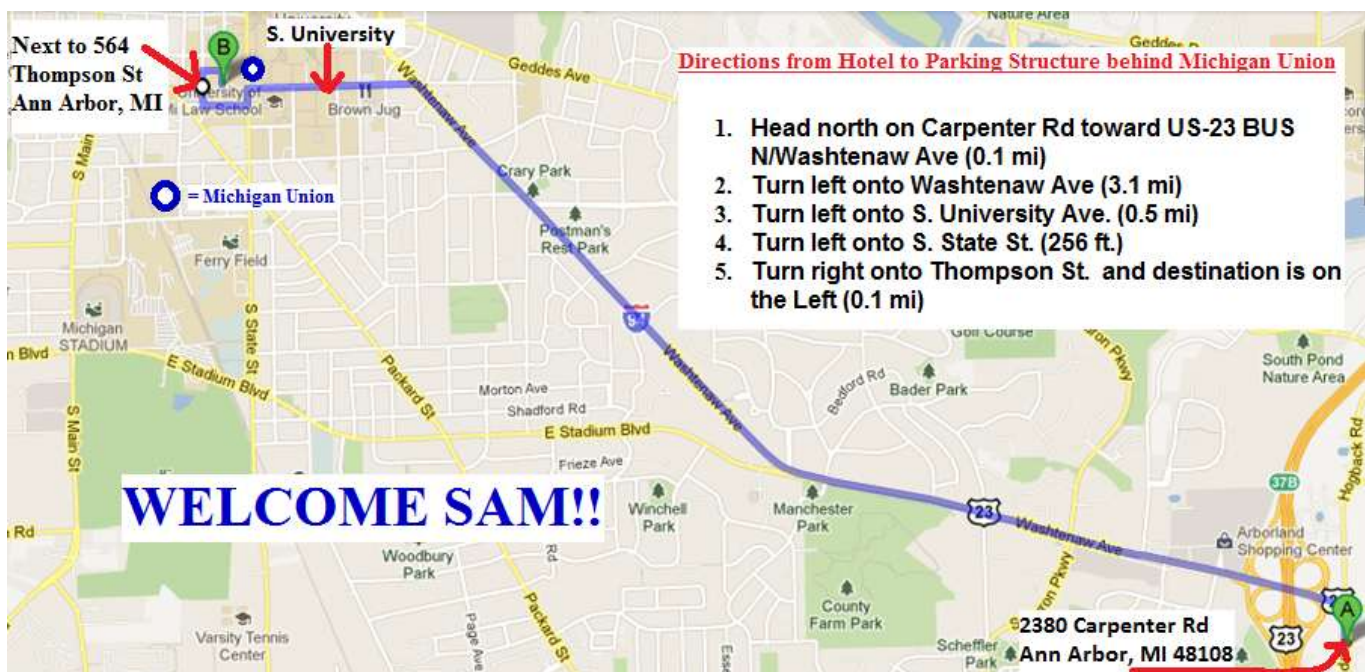

## Parking/Transportation

Below is a map to the visitor's parking lot nearest the conference. Fortunately, because it is a weekend, parking should not be too difficult to find; however, using this lot is highly recommended.

Enter **541 Thompson St. Ann Arbor, MI 48109** into your GPS if you have one or see the map. However, remember that you want to park in the **PARKING LOT** and not the structure right next to it. See the directions from the lot to the conference below (it's a 2 minute walk, don't worry!)



Once you park, cross the street and walk left until you reach Richard L. Kennedy Drive. Continue down that until you reach a circle drive and you should find doors to enter the building just past that (there is a covered fountain right next to the entrance). Continue straight inside the building and you should find elevators on the right. Take the elevator to third floor. Once you reach the third floor, turn left and go to the end of the hall to find the Michigan Student Assembly offices. Our meeting will take place in there. If you get confused, ask someone for the Michigan Union (though this is a really short walk).

If the lot on Thompson is full at any point, use the structure below or find a meter (though be sure it isn't a two hour limit)
